

Session I Part 6: Creating A Title

In this presentation you will learn how to create a title inside your tile bar by using an assortment of font modification menus.

You will begin by selecting the Text box.



After the text box has been selected drag your mouse across the center of the screen.



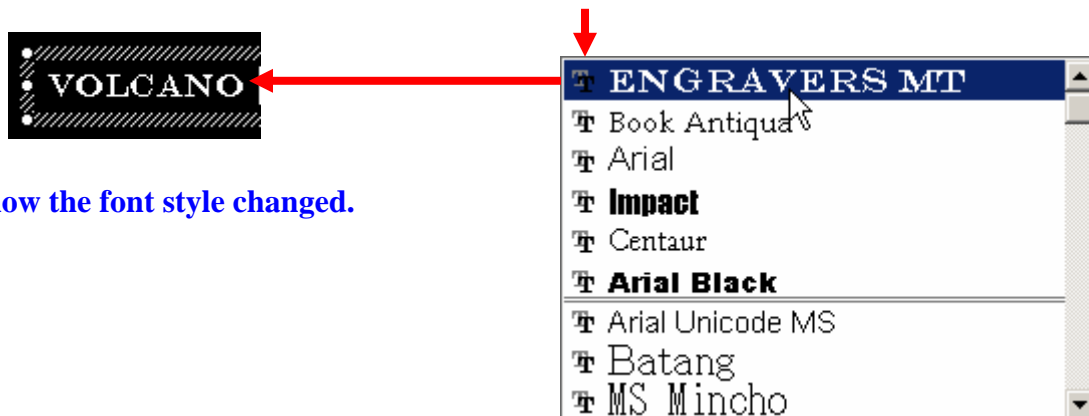
Notice how the text “I bar” is located on the left hand side of the highlighted space. This is where you will type your title.

Type the word “VOLCANO” in all caps by selecting the caps lock key located left hand side of your keyboard.



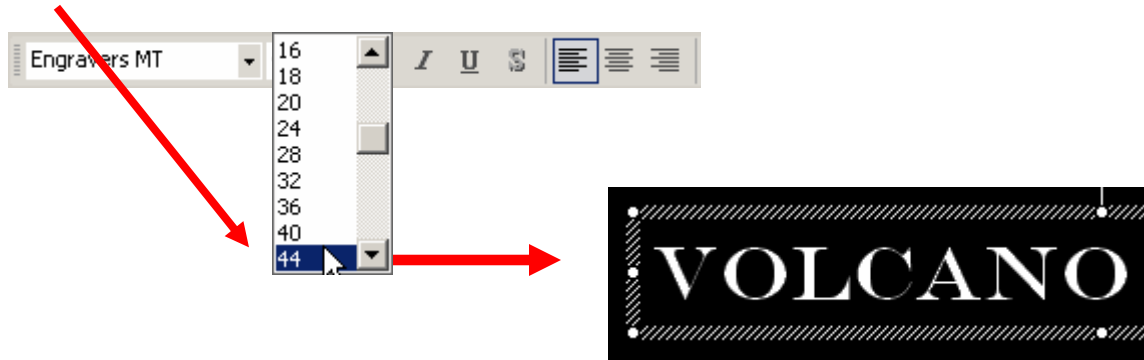
Now with the word “VOLCANO” being highlighted you will modify your font by performing various font modification functions.

You will first change the type of font by selecting a font type from the font selection menu. Select the font Menu and change the font by clicking on the down arrow in the font menu selection box. You will need to select ENGRAVERS MT.

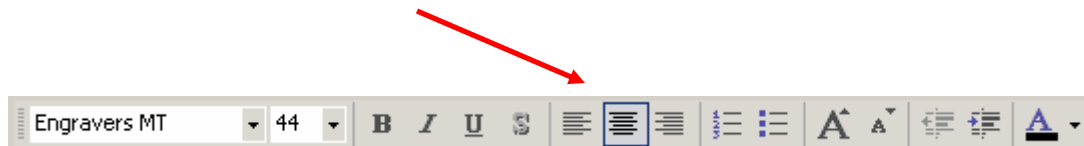


Notice how the font style changed.

Now you will need to change the size of your font by selecting the font size menu and select font size 44.



Next you will need to select Center.



This action will move the title to the center of the box.



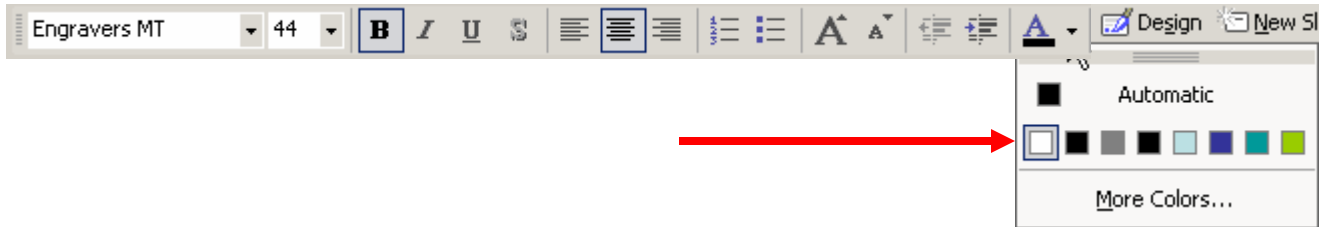
Then you will need to select bold.



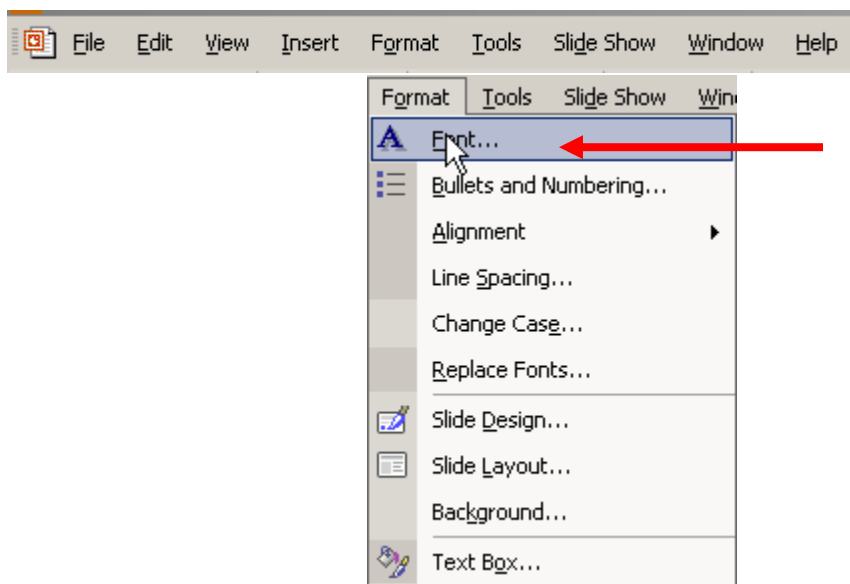
This function will widen the title.



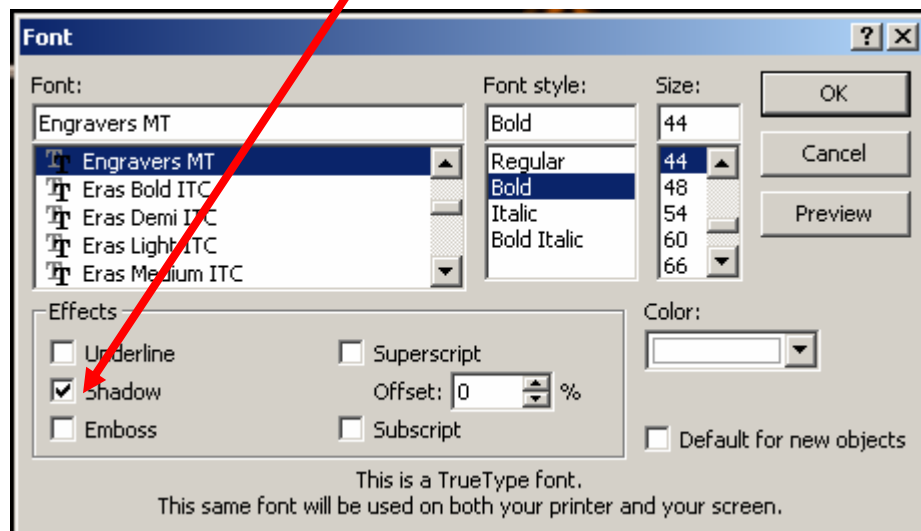
You will also need to select a color for your font. Since your font is on a black background you should [choose the color white](#).



You will add one additional feature to your title by selecting the format menu, then [select font](#).



This will open up the font display box. [Select shadow](#) by placing a checkmark.



The last step in creating a title is to move the font title inside the title bar. [Click on the title](#) and while holding down the right mouse key drag the title to its new location.
