



ENID PUBLIC SCHOOLS JUNIOR HIGH SUMMER ACADEMY 2008 ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

This year's tuition based summer program offers three core subject selections and an enrichment project for students that were in grades six through eight during the 2007-08 school year.

The traditional Summer Academy classes will begin on June 2, 2008 and end on June 27, 2008. Cost for the program is \$155.00 per class. Credit for the class will be given if needed for promotion. Classes for the Summer Academy will be held at Emerson Junior High School which is located at 700 W. Randolph. Promotion credit will be subject to 95% attendance and demonstration of content mastery.

The enrichment project will consist of a two hour session that will meet for two-weeks, June 2 – 13, (cost \$80) integrating math, language arts, reading and art as the students learn about the history of Enid.

Parents wishing to enroll their child in the Summer Academy will need to complete and return the bottom portion of this brochure on or before May 30, 2008. We will only be offering these classes if we have ten or more students enrolled, and payment must be made in full before June 2, 2008.

ENID PUBLIC SCHOOLS JUNIOR HIGH SUMMER ACADEMY INFORMATION SHEET

One session of the traditional Summer Academy will be offered from June 2 thru June 27. The classes will begin at 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. - Monday through Friday. Classes will be held at Emerson Junior High and there will be a \$155.00 enrollment fee for each class, due prior to or on the first day of class. Also, before a class can be taught, there will have to be 10 or more students enrolled and the full payment will have to be paid before the first day of classes. Transportation will be the responsibility of the individual student.

Two sessions offering enrichment through the Kenwood Project will be held from June 2 – June 13, session one is from 8:00 – 9:45 a.m. and session 2 is from 10:00 – 11:45 a.m. The cost is \$80 per session. During this session students will learn about the history of Enid. They will have math, language arts, reading and art integrated into this program.

ATTENDANCE: A student may miss only two (2) days per session. It will be the student's responsibility to make-up work for days missed. If a student is absent more than two (2) days, a doctor's excuse will be required for readmittance.

TARDIES: Tardies may be excused only by a doctor's written statement. If a student is tardy to the summer program, the following procedure will be followed regardless of the excuse:

- 1st Tardy: Warning and written up by the teacher
- 2nd Tardy: Will count as one absence
- 3rd Tardy: Will count for 2 absences

If tardies 1, 2, 3 are excused, any subsequent tardies must also be excused by a doctor's excuse or the tardies may accumulate as absences.

STUDENT CONDUCT: Student behavior will be in accordance with the approved Student Handbook. If it becomes necessary for a teacher to refer a student to the Summer Program Director for disciplinary reasons, the following procedure will be followed:

- 1st Referral: The Director will counsel the student and his or her parent or guardian will be contacted
- 2nd Referral: The student will be removed from the summer program IMMEDIATELY with no refund.

DRESS CODE: Enid Public School dress code will be enforced during the Summer Program sessions. Any article of clothing or attire that tends to disrupt the learning process will not be permitted.
